GEAI is pleased to share its inaugural newsletter, spotlighting some key milestones from the last quarter of 2024 through the first quarter of 2025. We closed 2024 with the successful Girls Education Summit (GES'24), held in collaboration with the Nigeria Youth SDGs Network. The summit convened stakeholders and marginalized girls to advance girls' right to quality education through policy and practice. In early 2025, GEAI deepened its partnerships by engaging in the FCT Coalition to End Child Marriage meeting, paying a courtesy visit to the Ministry of Youth, and participating in the Conference of Commissioners and Permanent Secretaries of State Ministries of Women Affairs. To mark International Women's Day, GEAI partnered with the Tabitha Empowerment Centre to host a community outreach in Karonmajigi, empowering women with knowledge on gender equality and gender-based violence. The event ended with community pledges to support girls' education and stand against all forms of violence. On social media, our advocacy gained further traction, including through our Instagram Live series; in March, we hosted the Executive Director of SEGEI for a powerful conversation on discrimination in girls' education and the ongoing fight for girls' rights. None of this would be possible without our dedicated partners and supporters. Thank you for believing in our mission -we look forward to continuing this journey with you.
